WHO WE ARE

The Center for Philanthropy Studies (CEPS) is an institute within the University of Basel. Our Institute pursues its goals in close cooperation with other university bodies, especially the faculties.

The primary research focus of the CEPS is philanthropy in all of its different operational and organizational forms. The CEPS defines philanthropy as any private, voluntary action for the common good.

The CEPS develops activities based on the understanding that, in general, philanthropy:

- serves to further the development and stability of society.
- needs a formal structure and special management methods to accommodate its administrative and organizational requirements,
- requires interdisciplinary research.

WHAT WE DO

The CEPS aspires to be the point of contact at a university level for philanthropy and foundations in Switzerland. Our focus is to facilitate the understanding of topics related to philanthropy and their impact in society.

CEPS activities generate research-based knowledge on philanthropy and foundations. Activities also include providing research services, continuing education and lectures, and consulting and information brokering. These services are intended for students, course participants, and other customers, as well as for individuals in government, business and members of the general public.

Generating Knowledge

 The CEPS contributes to the development of a modern understanding of philanthropy in different research areas. Through various innovative research projects, the Institute is recognized internationally a research institution.

Imparting Knowledge

 The CEPS promotes philanthropy, which directly benefits foundations and other non-profit organizations, by offering lectures, continuing education, coaching and other information services.
